

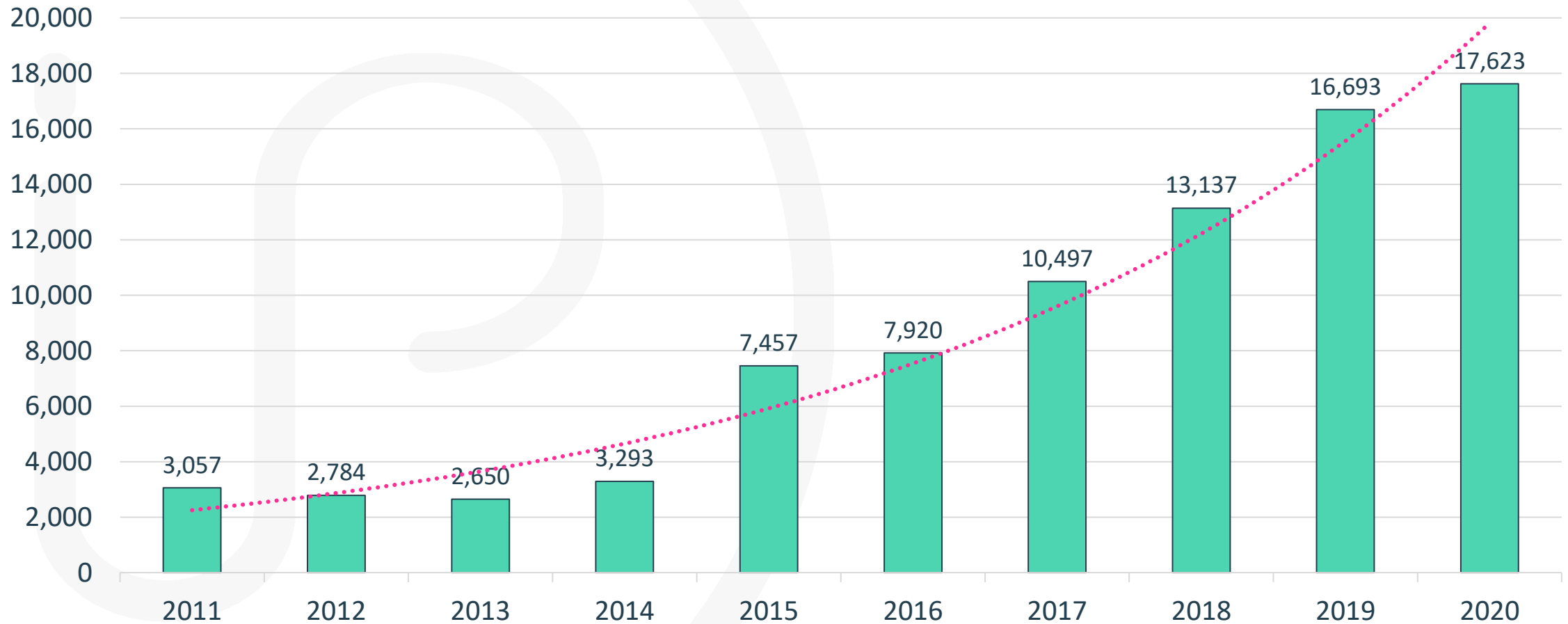

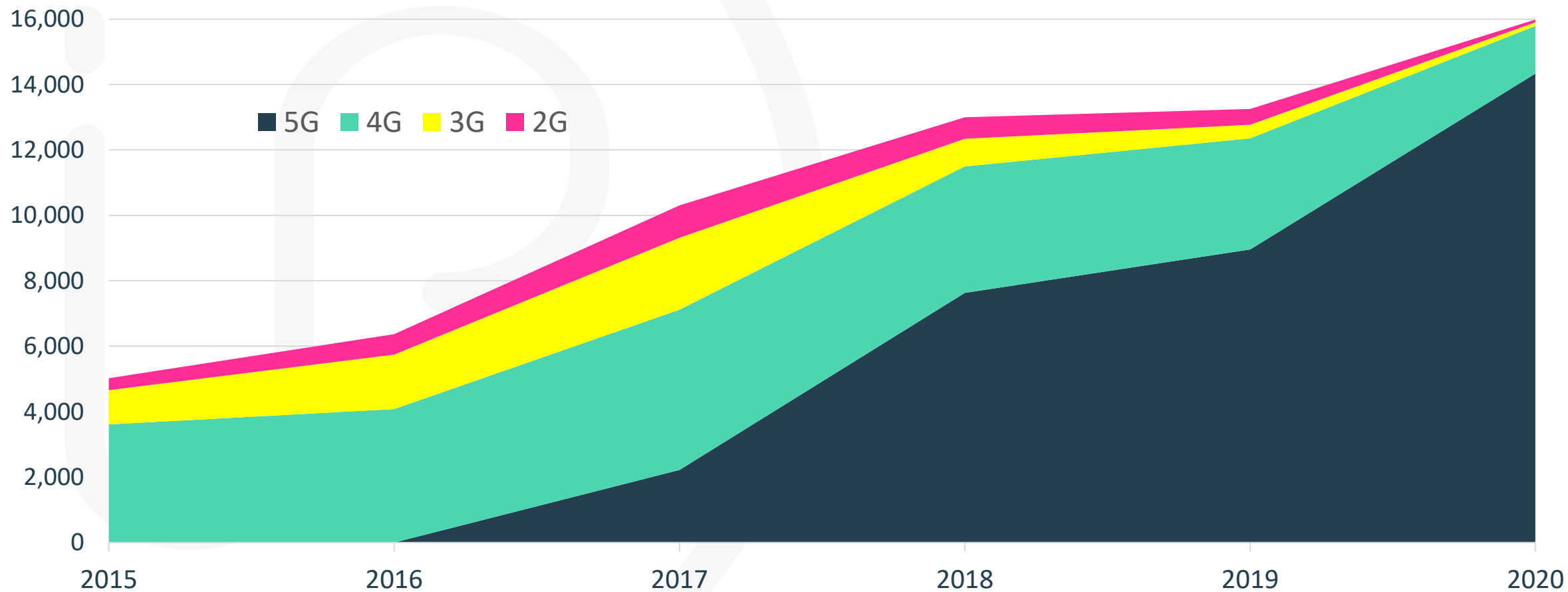

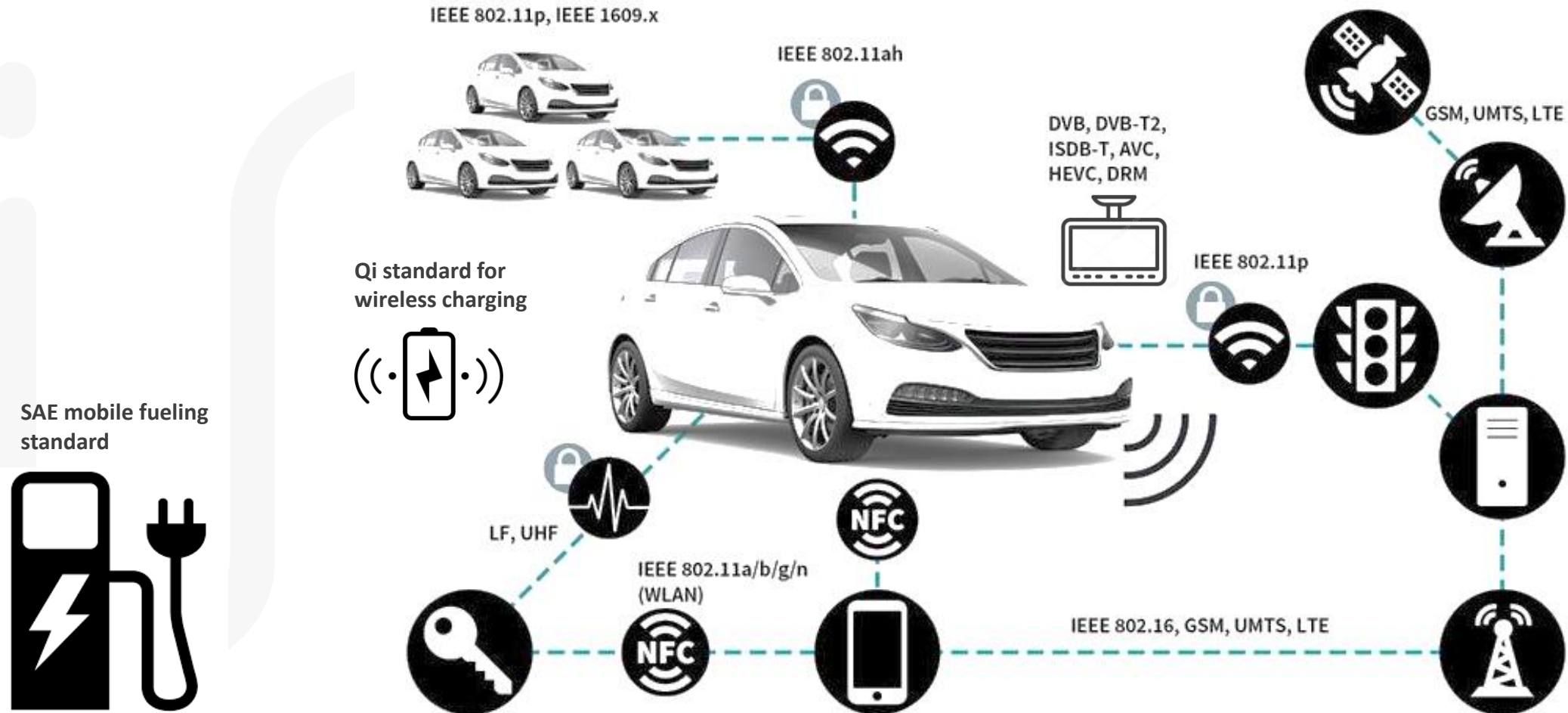
Declared patent families as to year of declaration



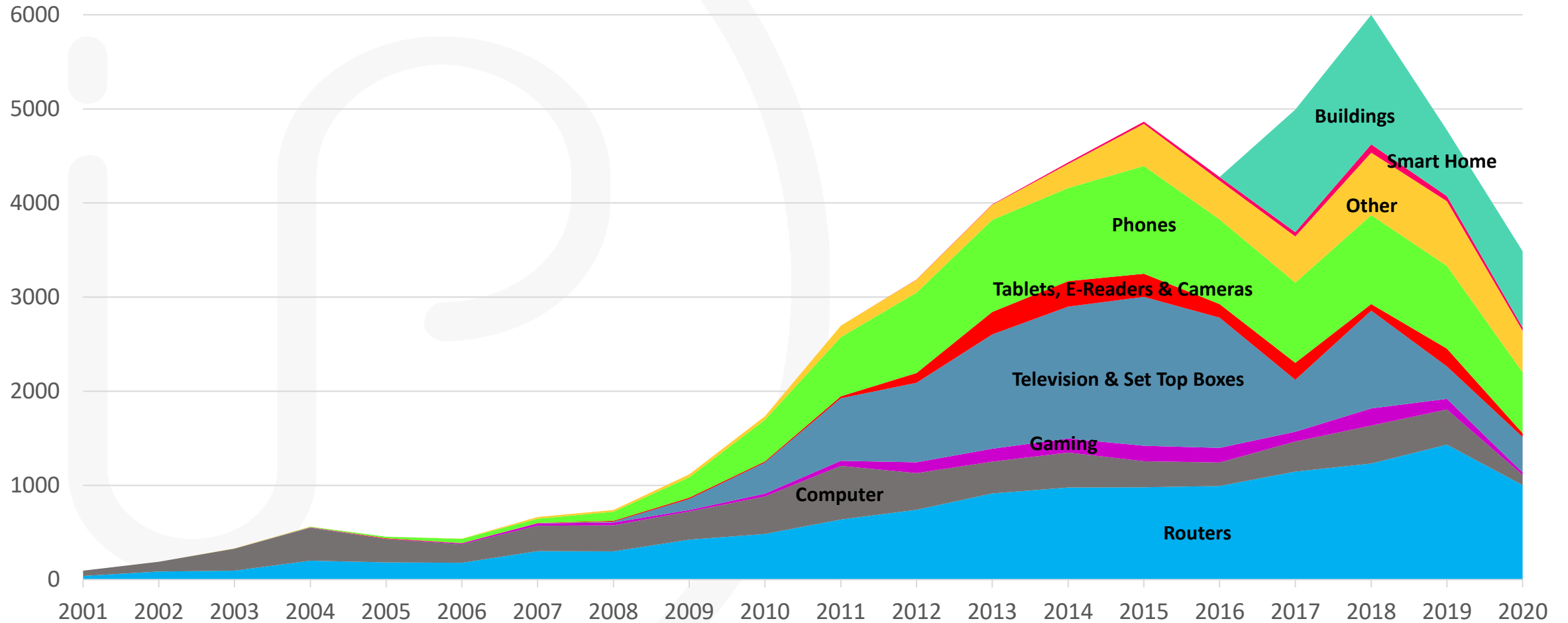
3G, 4G 5G declared patent families as to year of declaration



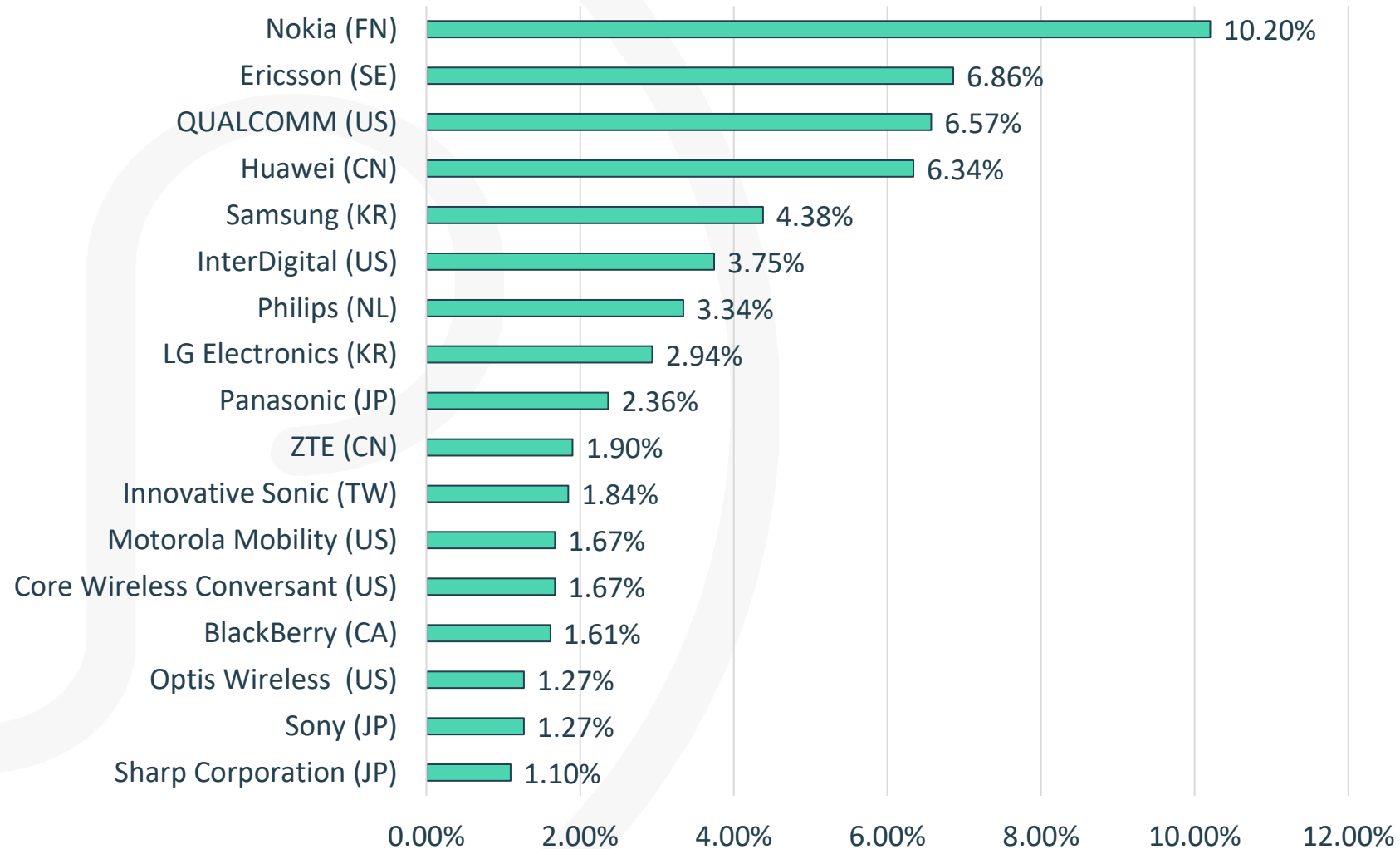
Standards in the connected vehicles



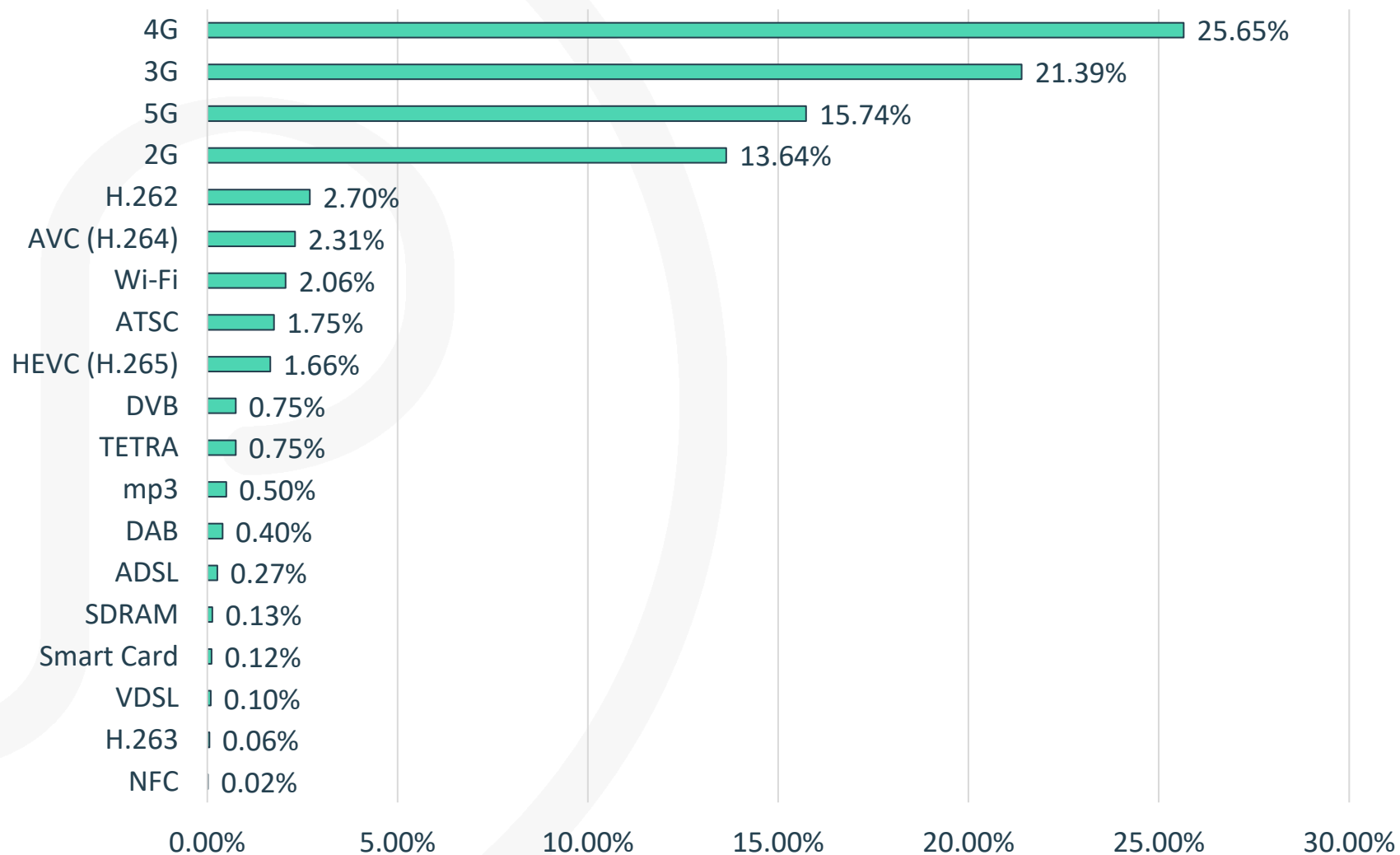
Wi-Fi adoption (Wi-Fi Alliance certified products)



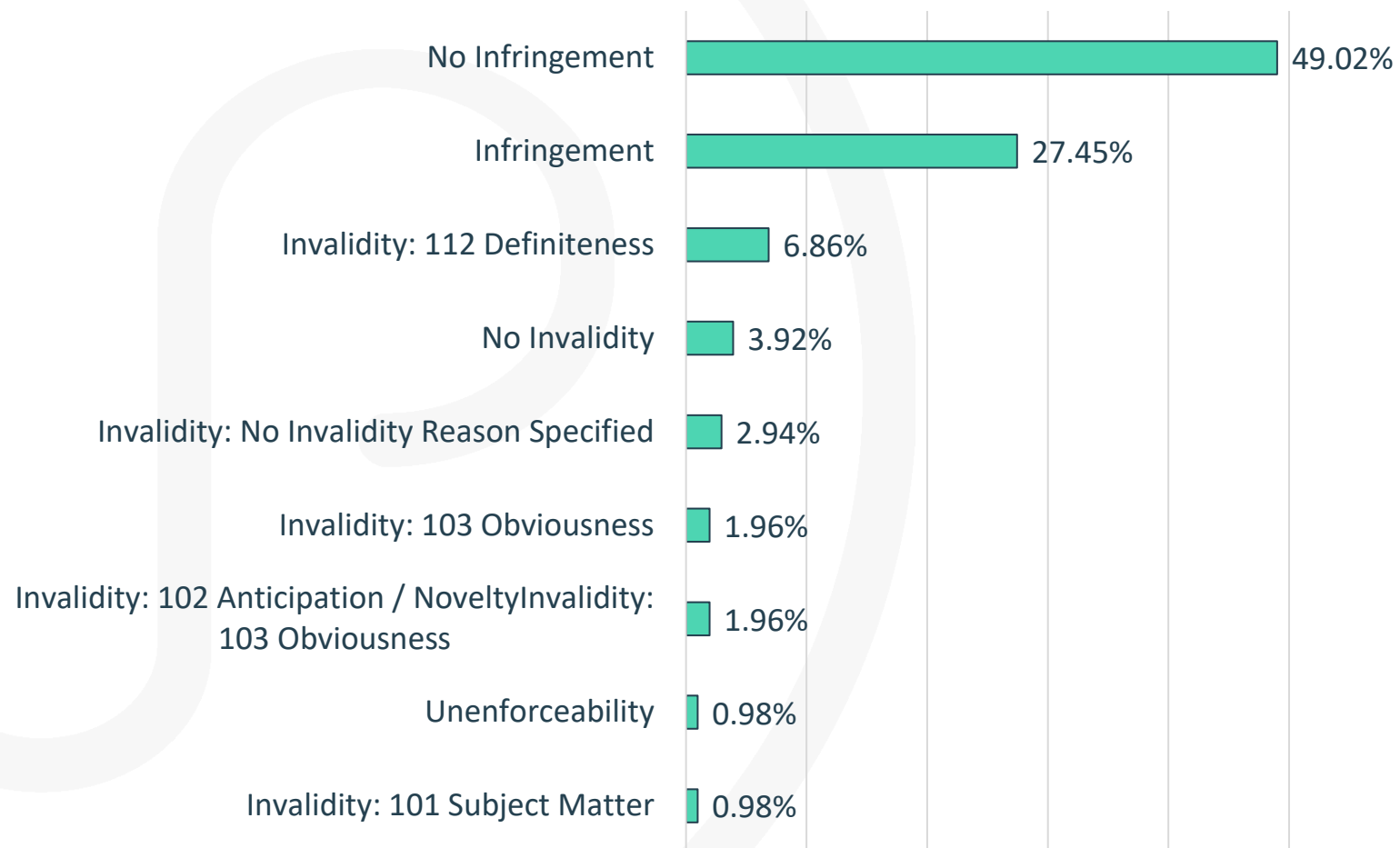
Plaintiff in SEP related litigation 2001-2021 (world-wide)

Q 1: With respect to FRAND, which best reflects your view? (N=351)

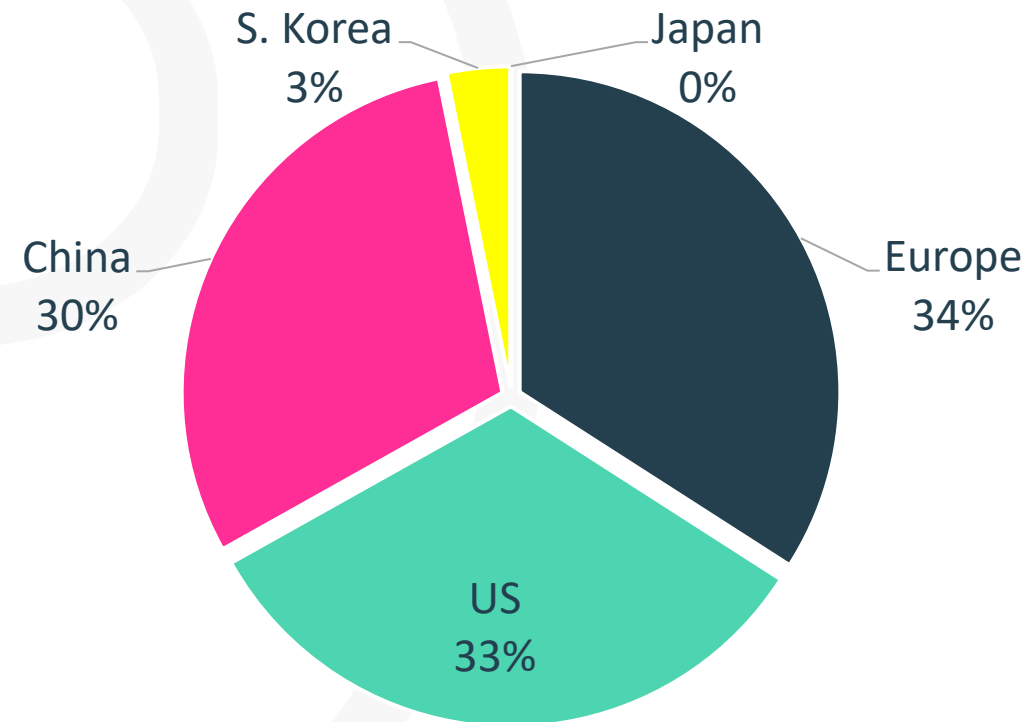
Patent Owners should be allowed to license only at the supply chain level of their choosing.

34.92%

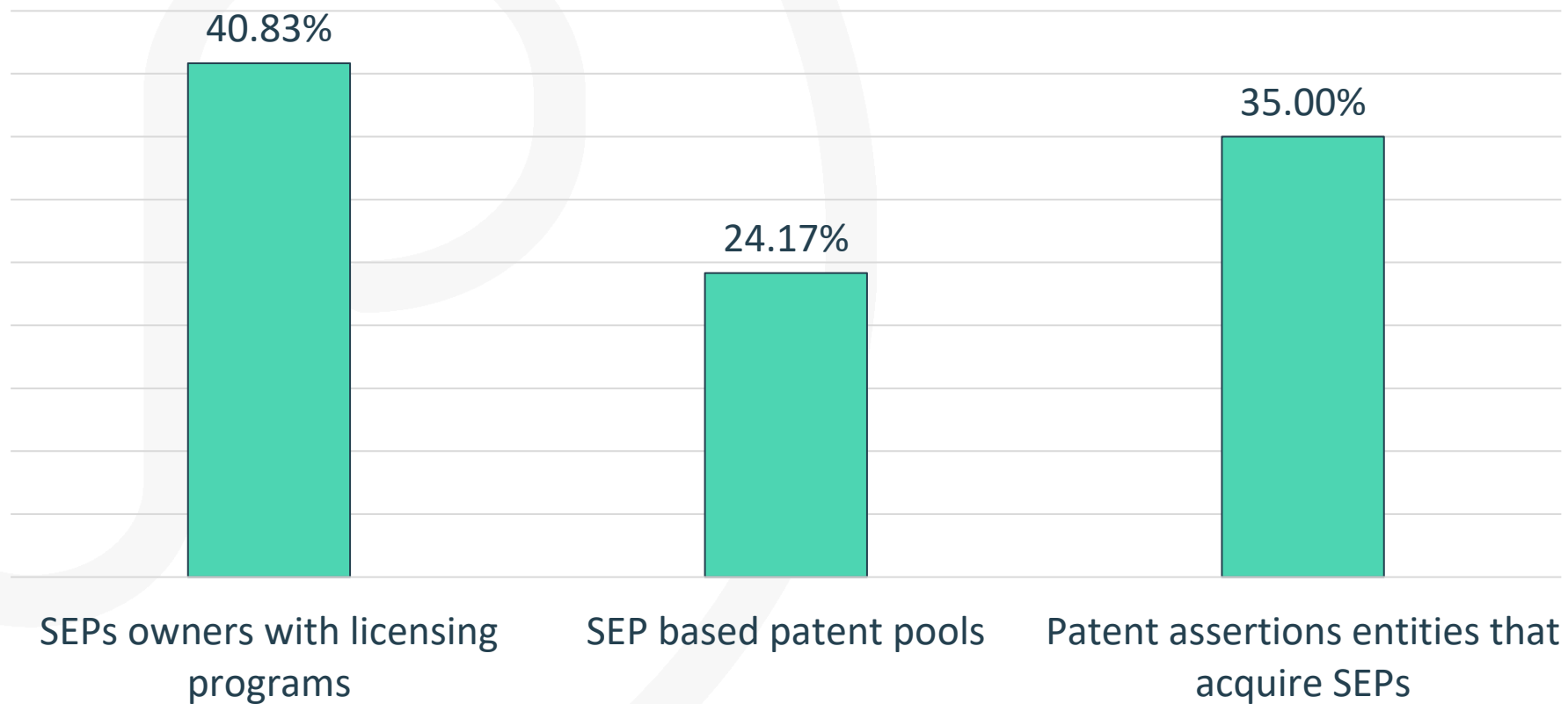
FRAND requires licenses to license any company that seeks a FRAND license, including suppliers of standardized components.

Q 3: Who will drive SEP litigation in the upcoming years on the plaintiff side? (N=294)



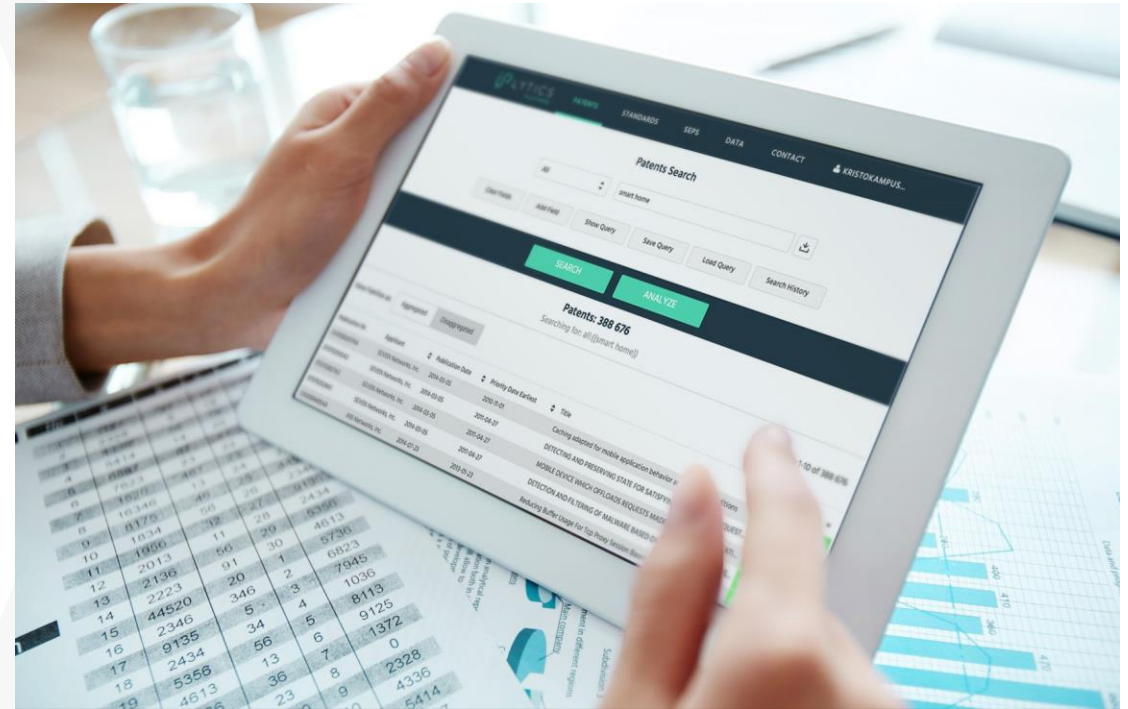
